Camp will provide lunch to workers. The event will run from 9am to 3pm each day. Come for a day or camp on your own overnight. All ages welcome!

Horseback riding is offered to girls only, for an additional fee ON A FIRST COME FIRST SERVE BASIS. 30 riders can be accommodated Saturday. Additional rides can be scheduled for Friday or Sunday.

**CHAPERONES must accompany campers.** One adult may chaperone more than one camper. Chaperones must register, paying a reduced fee.
